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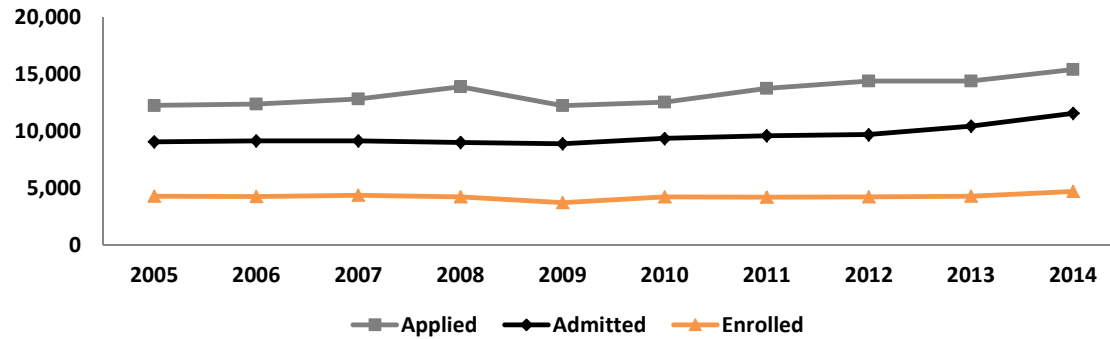

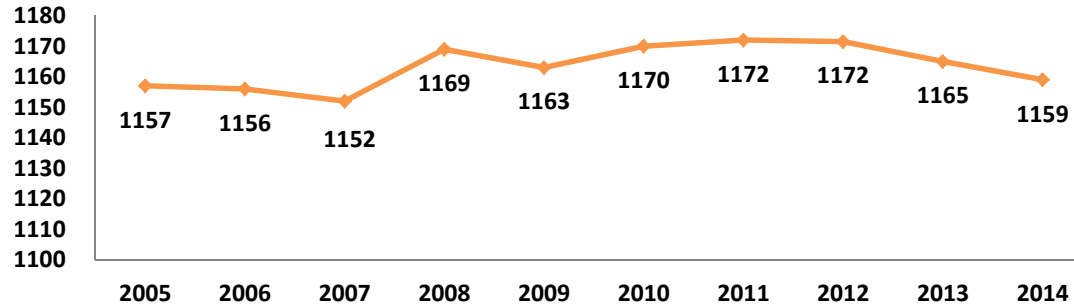

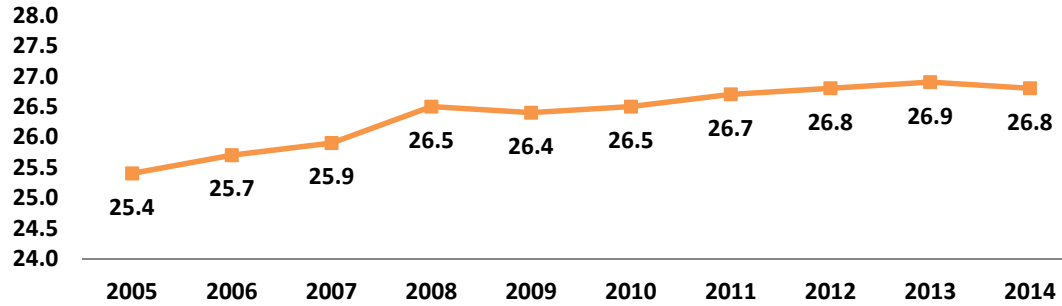

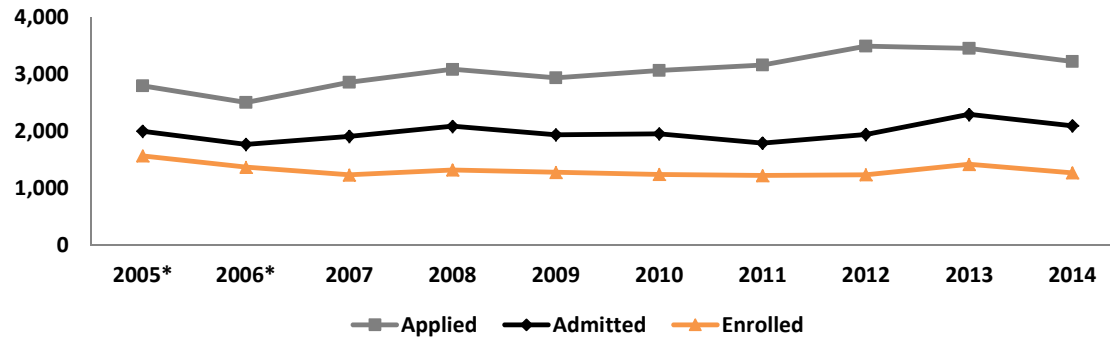

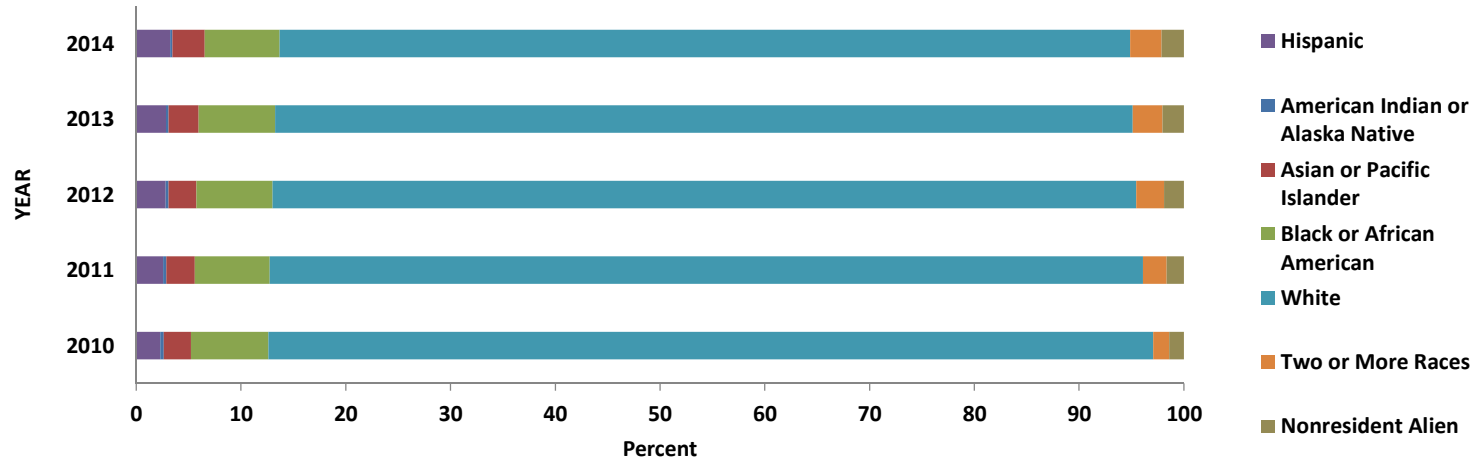

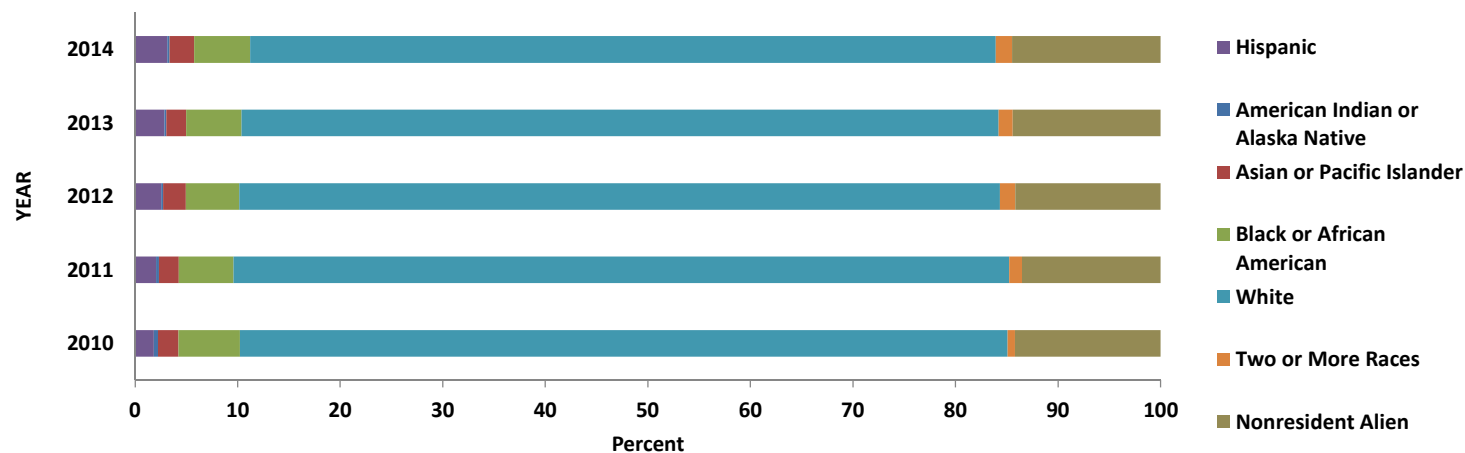

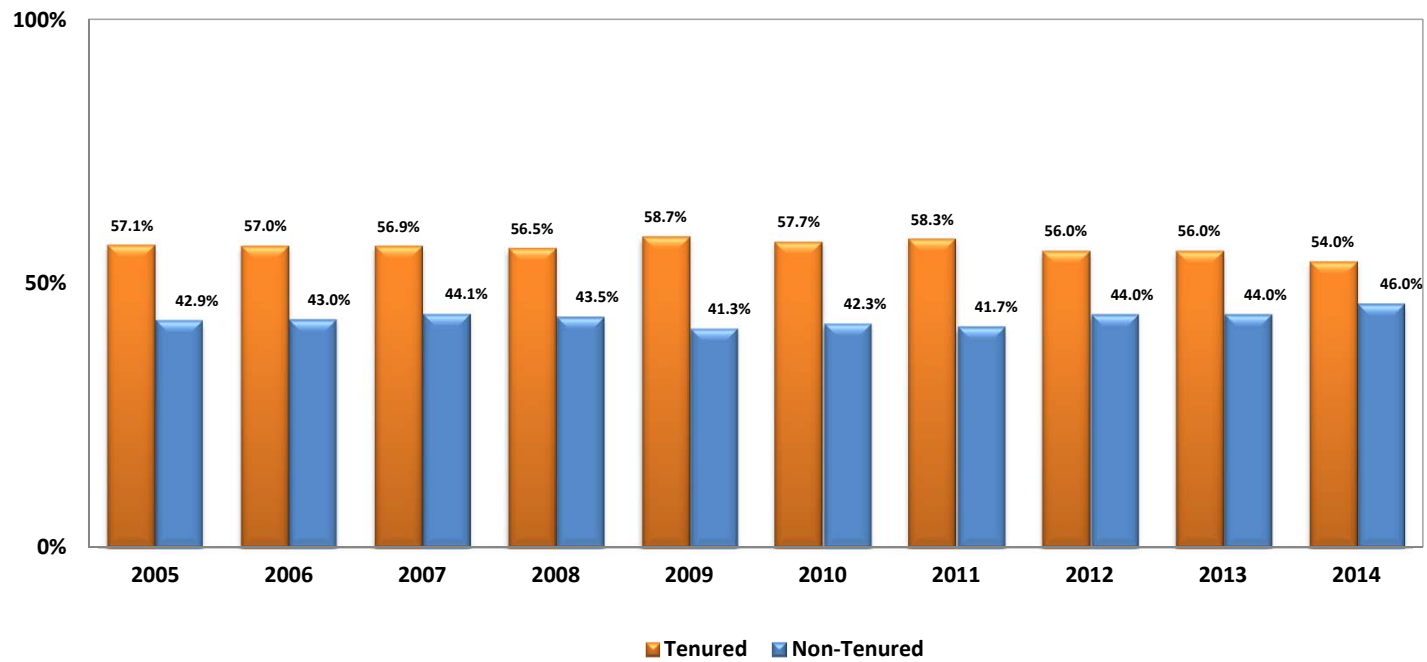

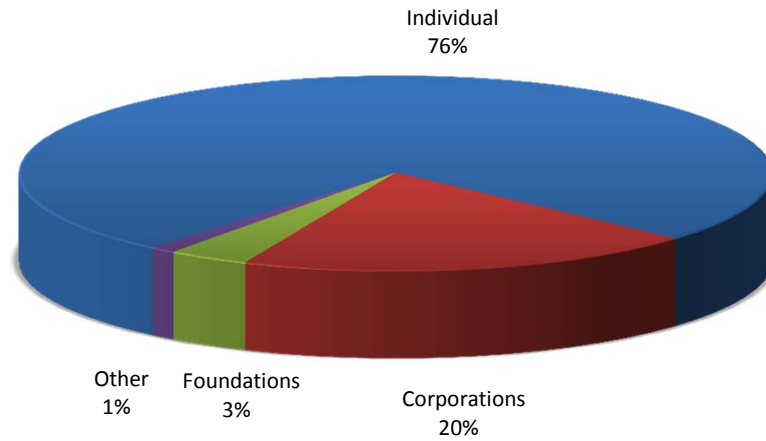

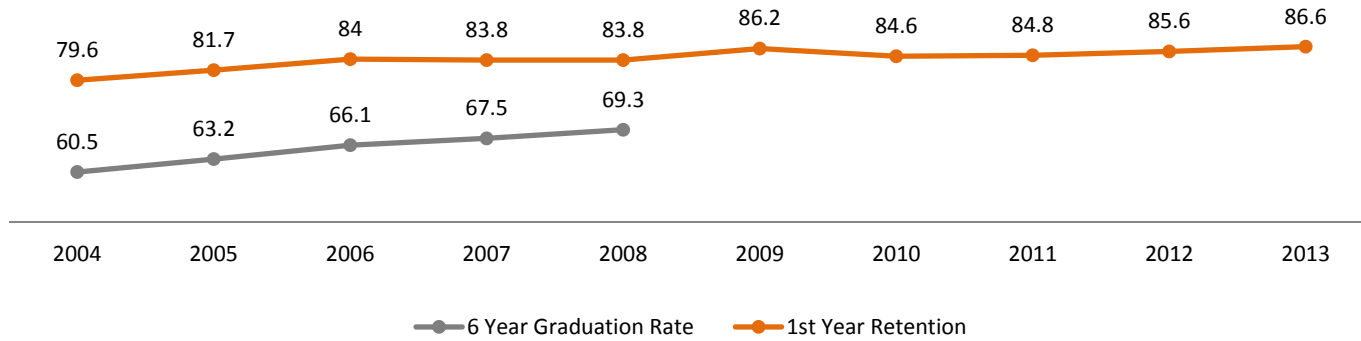

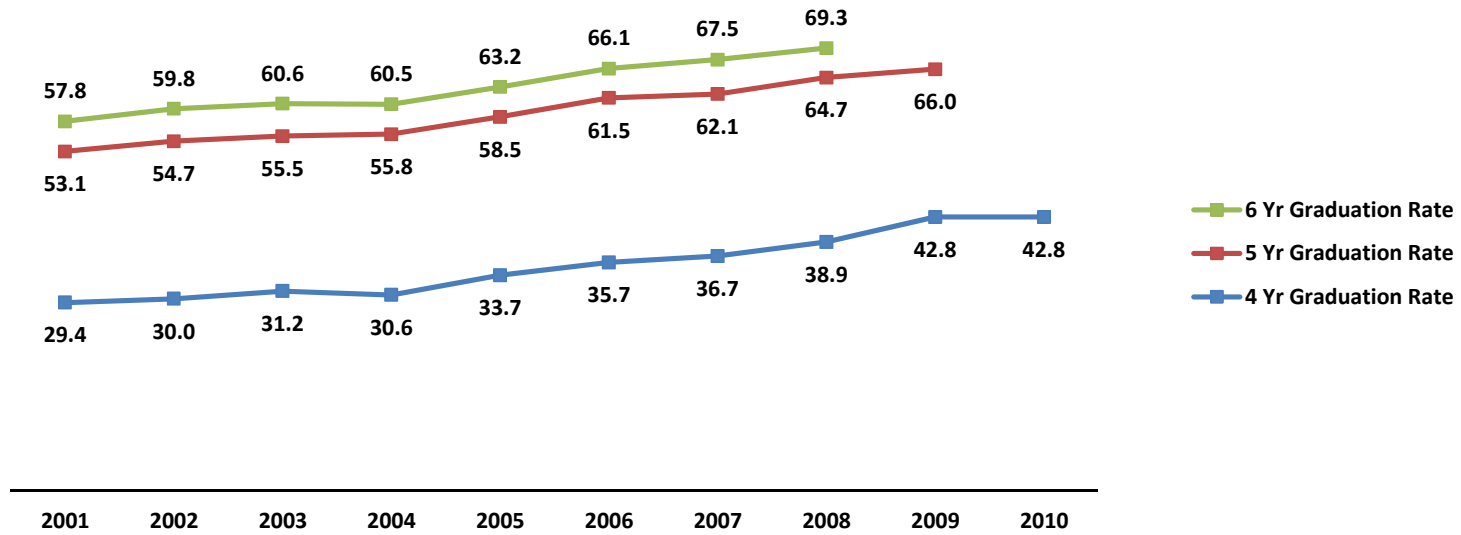
10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Full-time Freshman Fall Cohorts 2004-2013

10 Year Trend of Fall Term Graduation Rates First-Time Full-Time Freshman

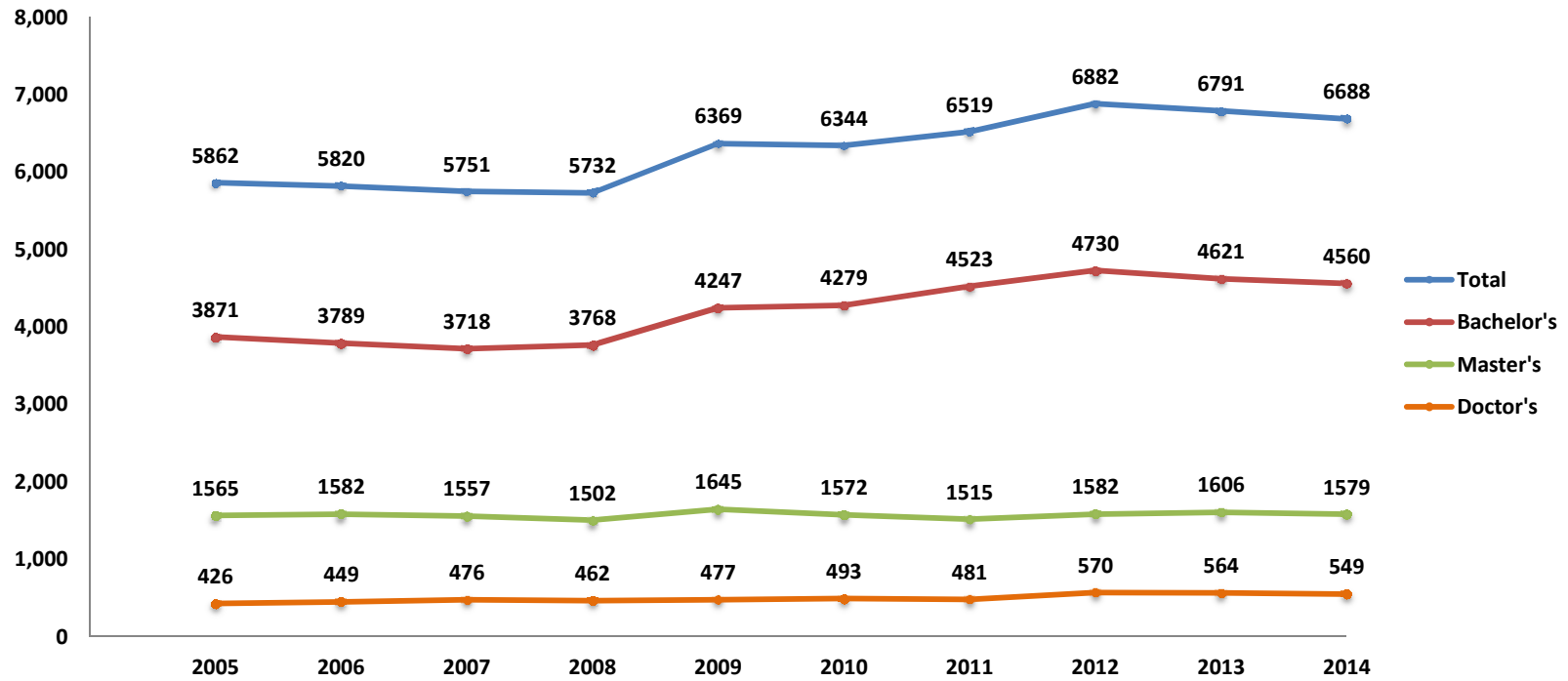
