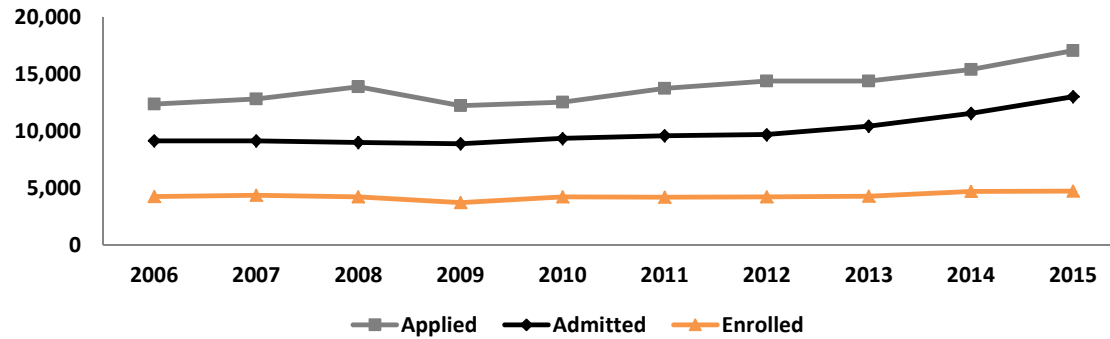

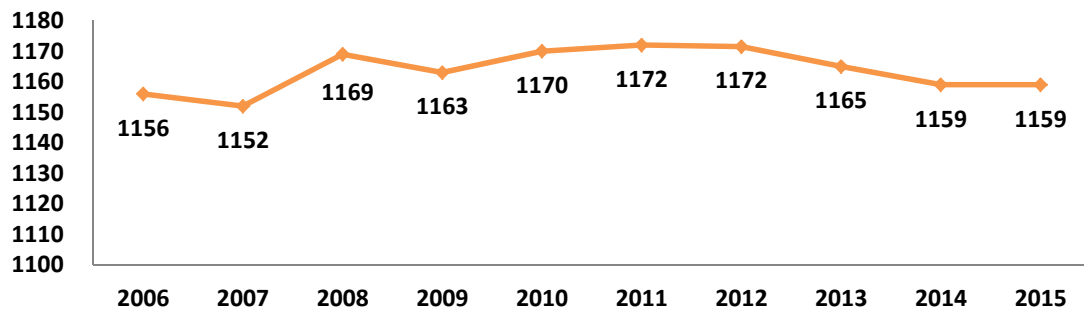

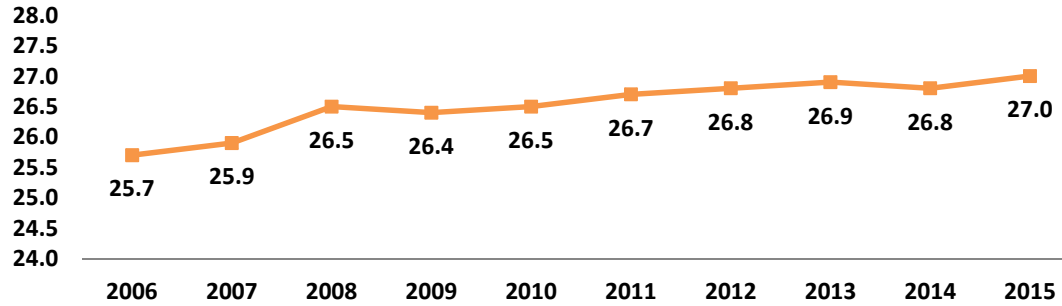
10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2006-2015

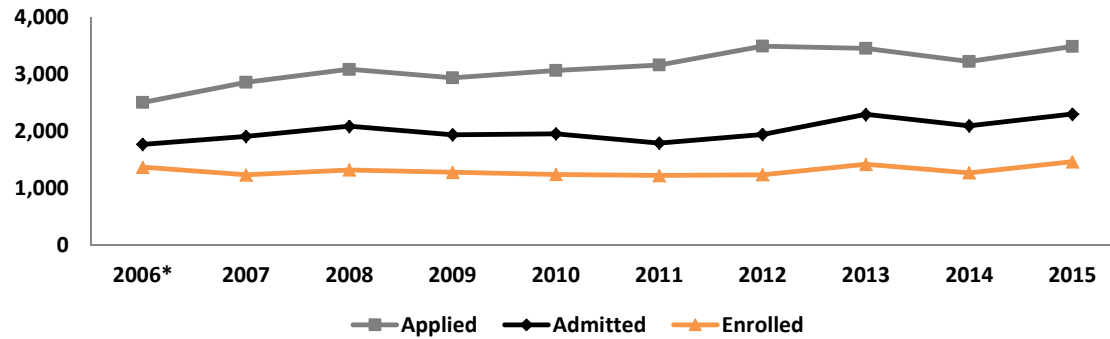

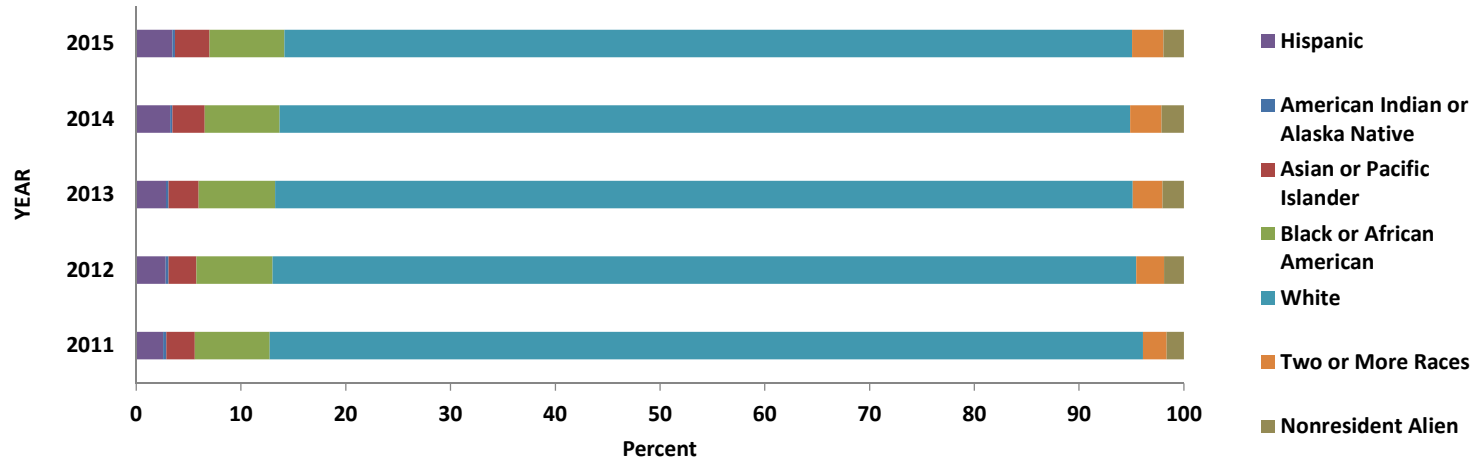

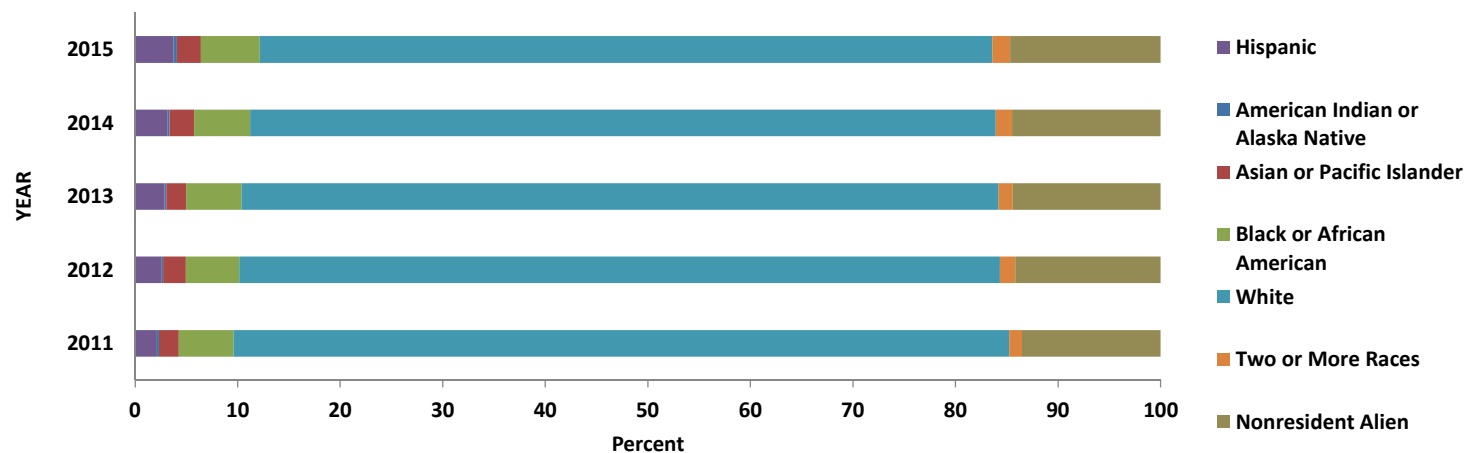

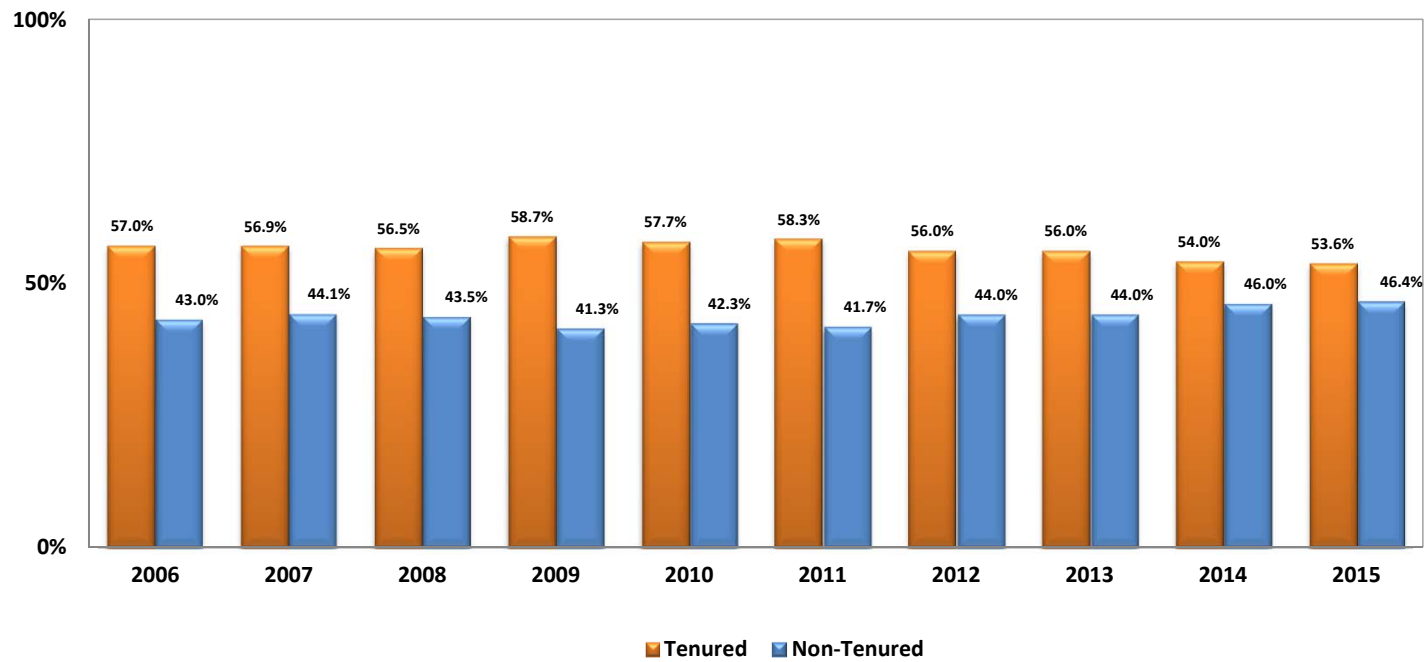

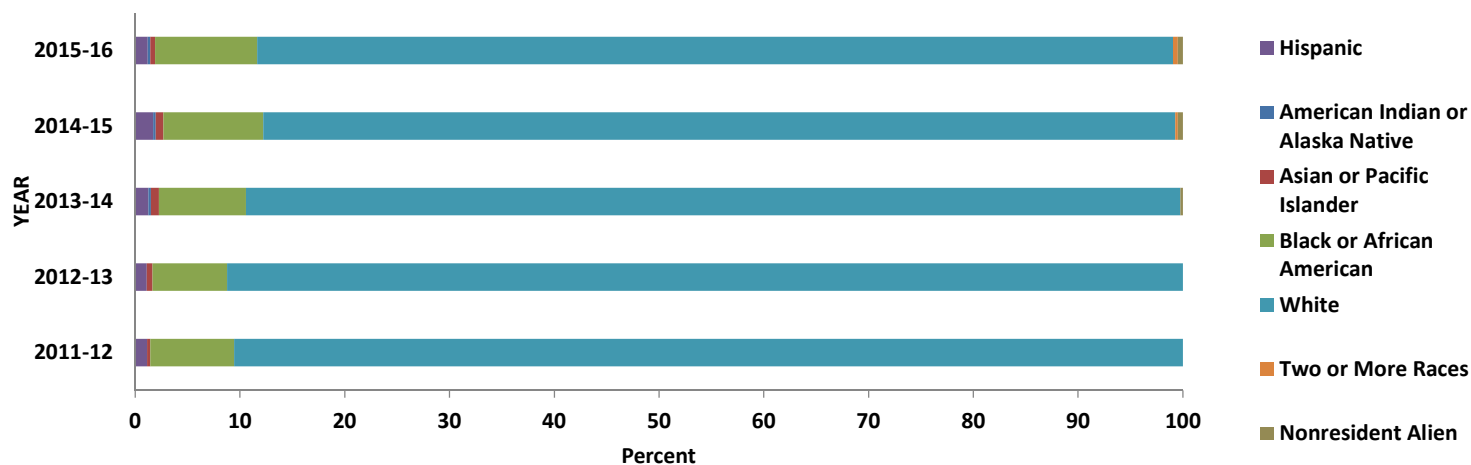

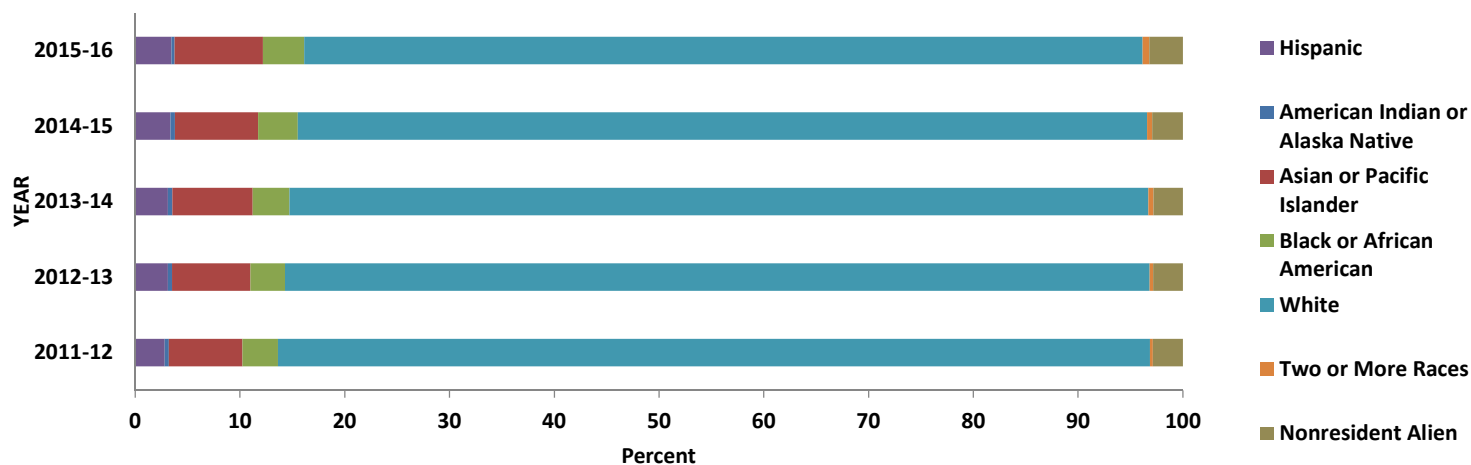
5 Year Trend of Executive and Administrative Employees By Race/Ethnicity Fall 2011-2015

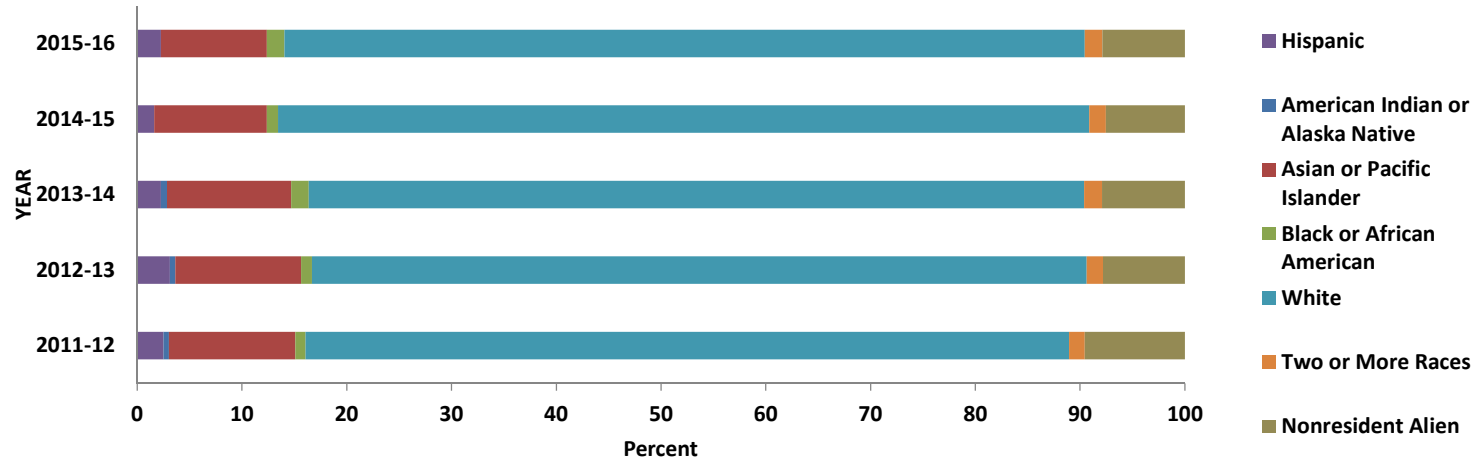
5 Year Trend of Instructional Faculty By Race/Ethnicity Fall 2011-2015

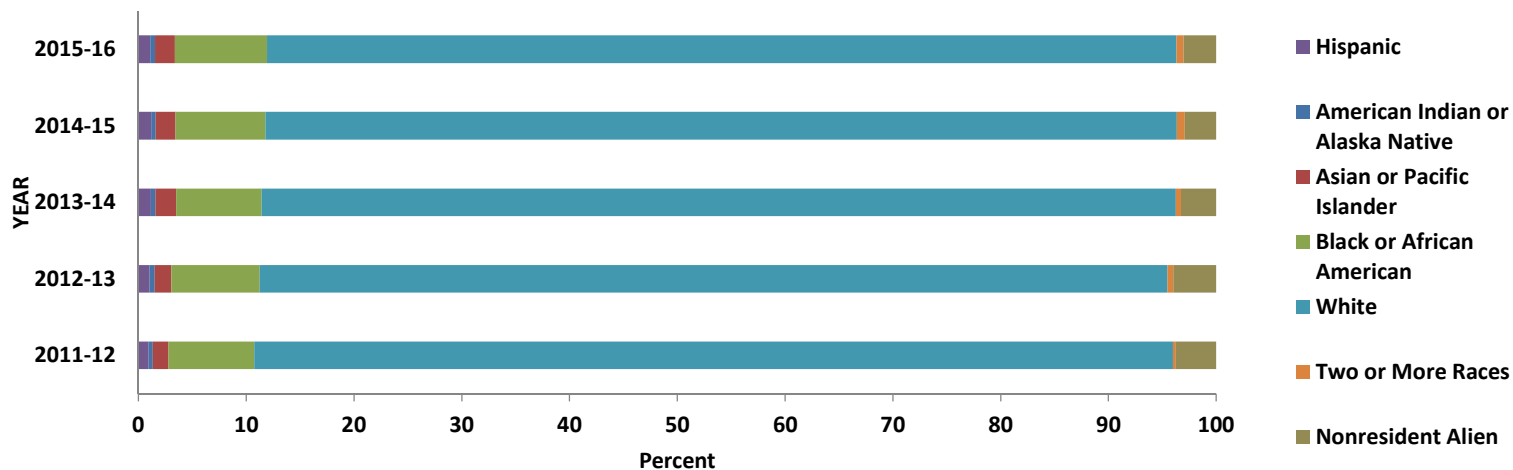
5 Year Trend of Research and Public Service Faculty By Race/Ethnicity Fall 2011-2015

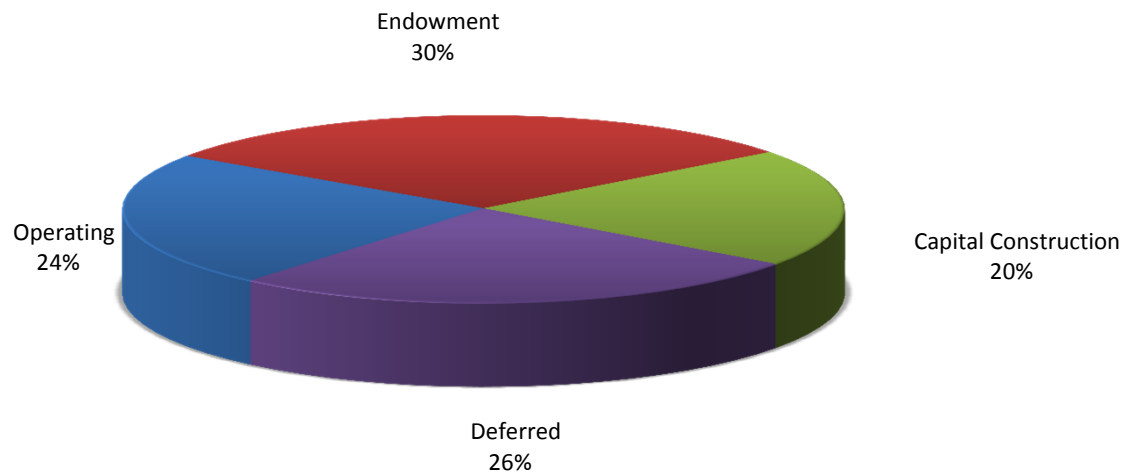


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

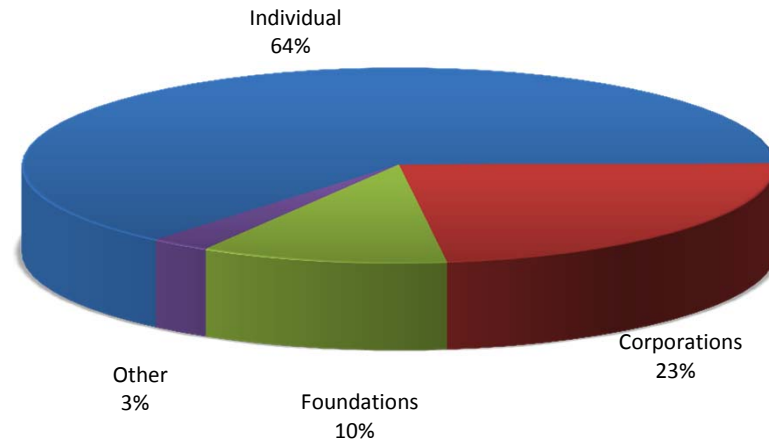


UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

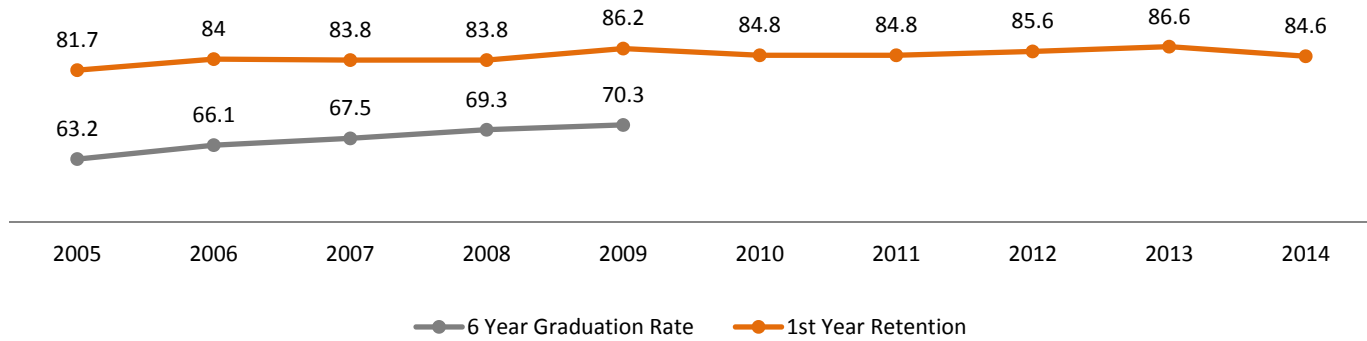

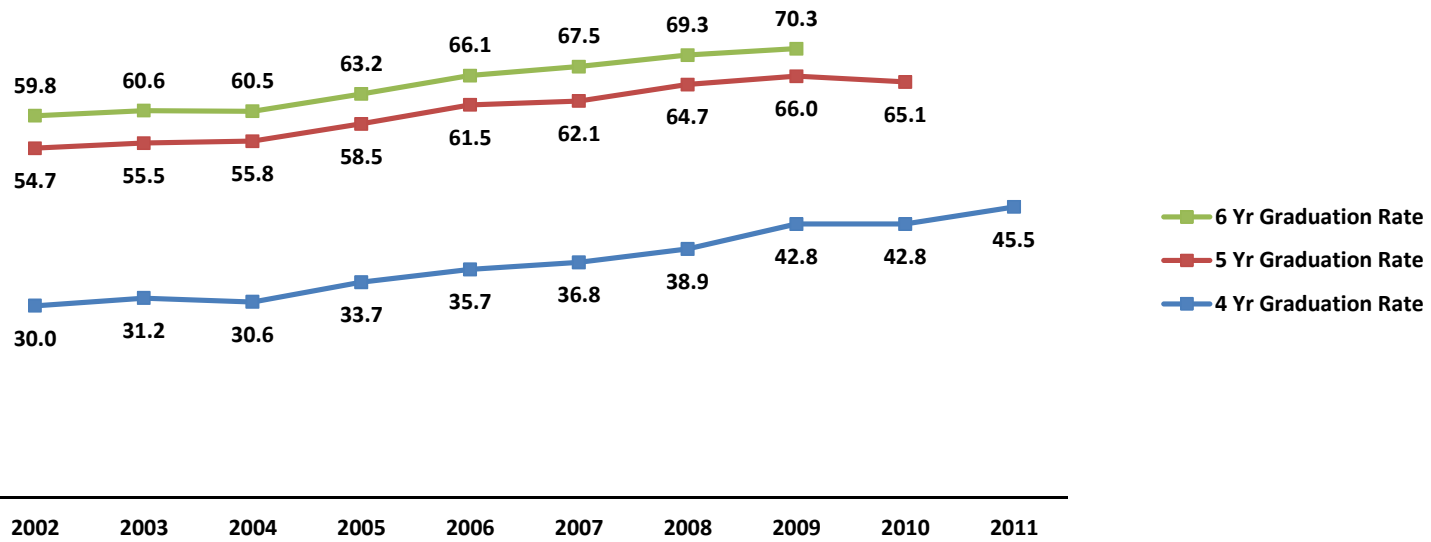
10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Full-time Freshman Fall Cohorts 2005-2014

10 Year Trend of Fall Term Graduation Rates First-Time Full-Time Freshman

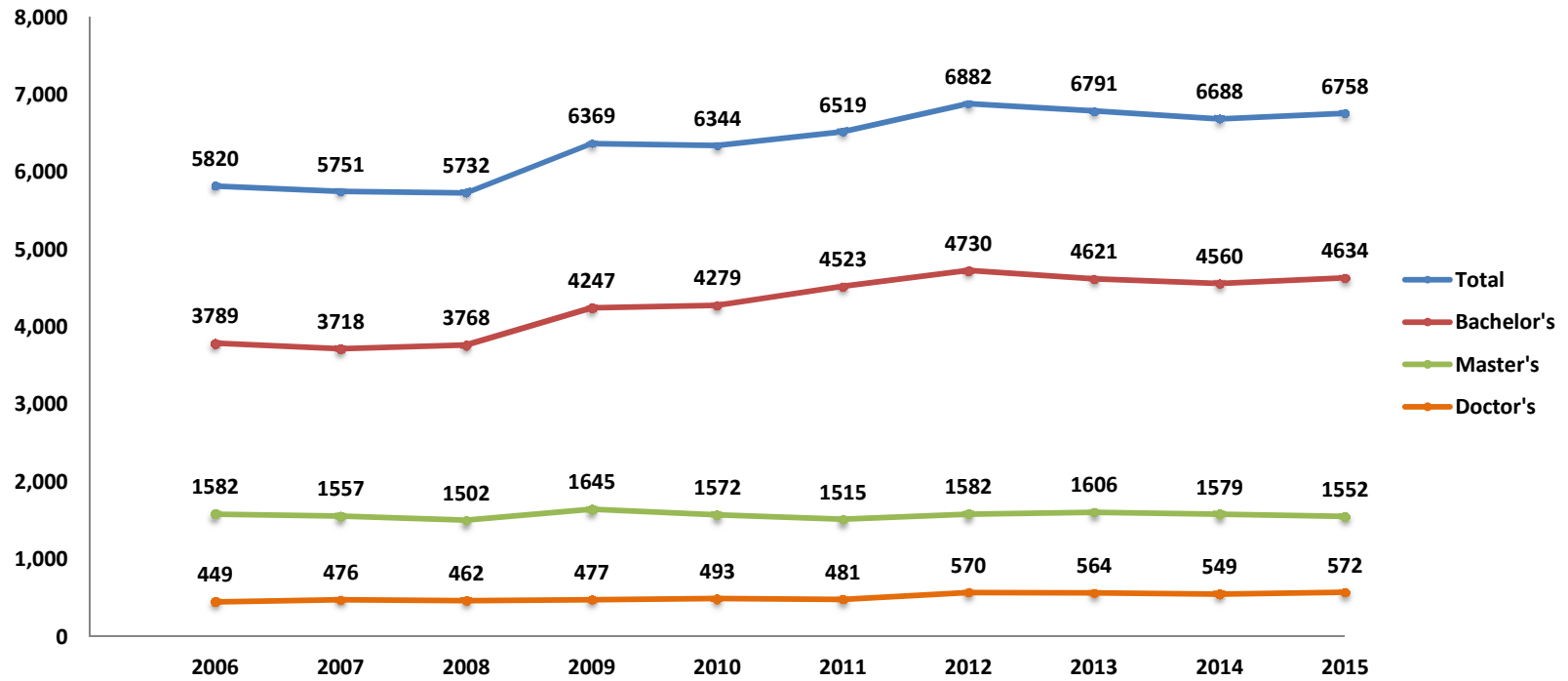

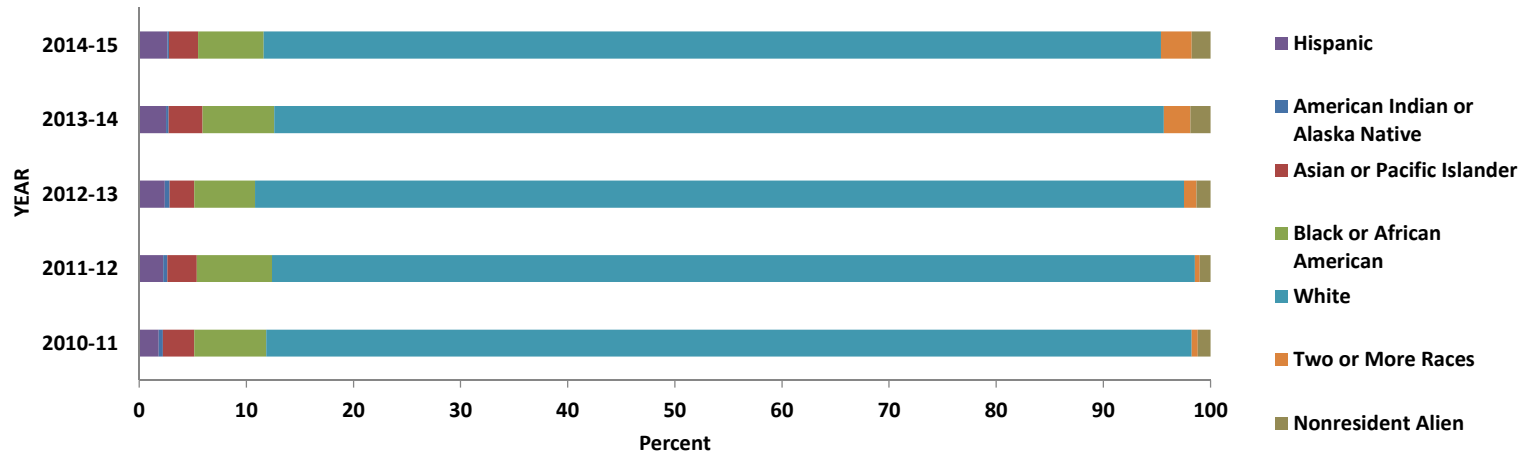

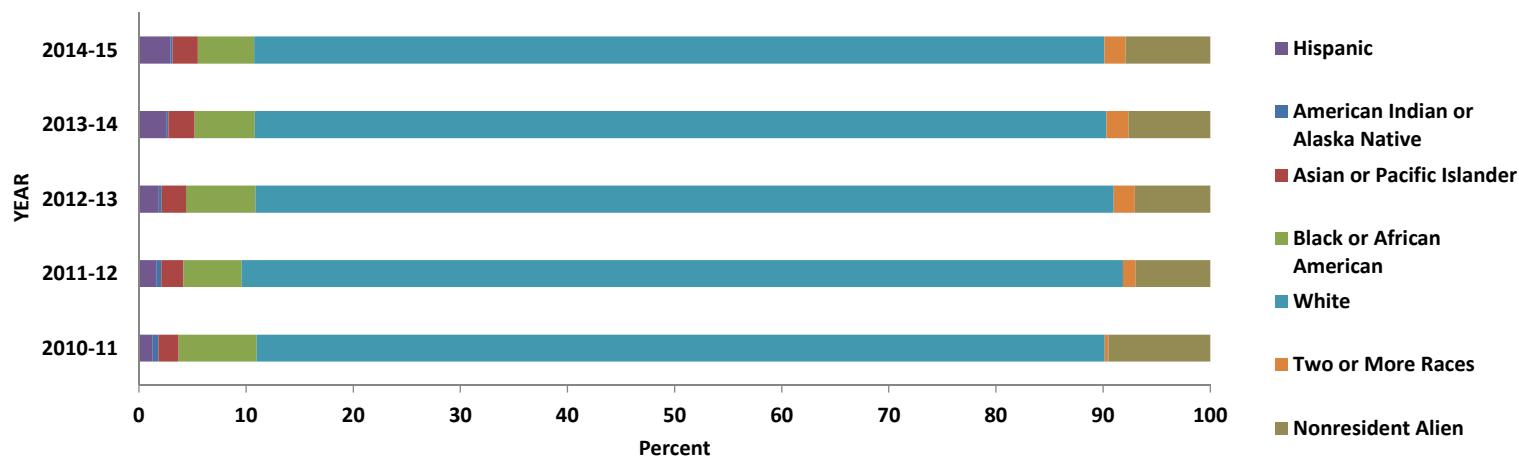
5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2010-2014

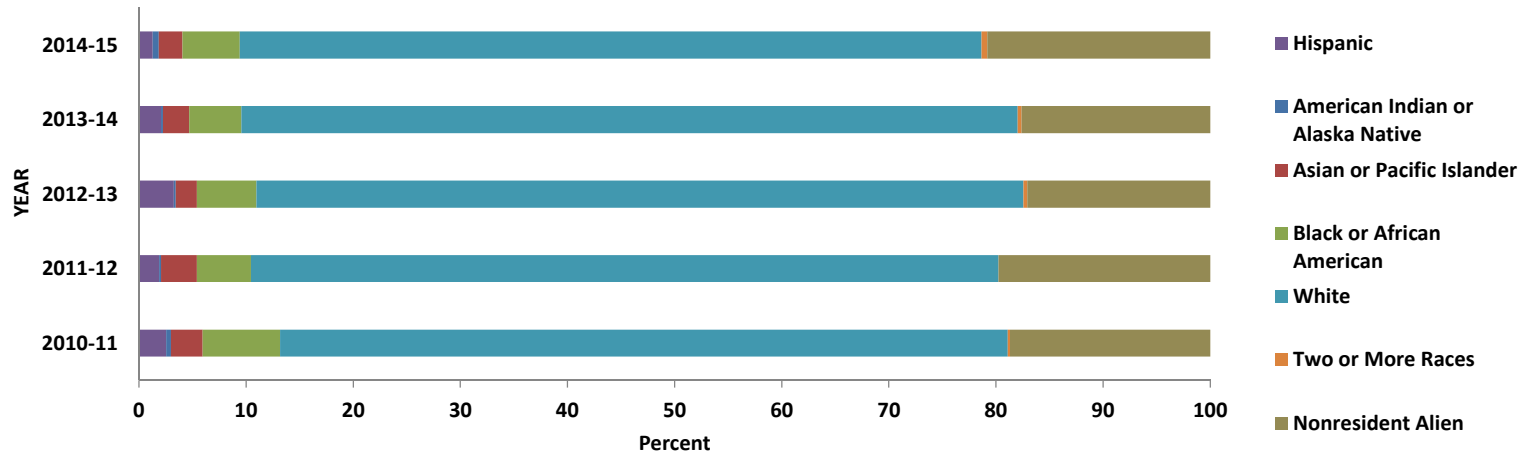
5 Year Trend of Master's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2010-2014
