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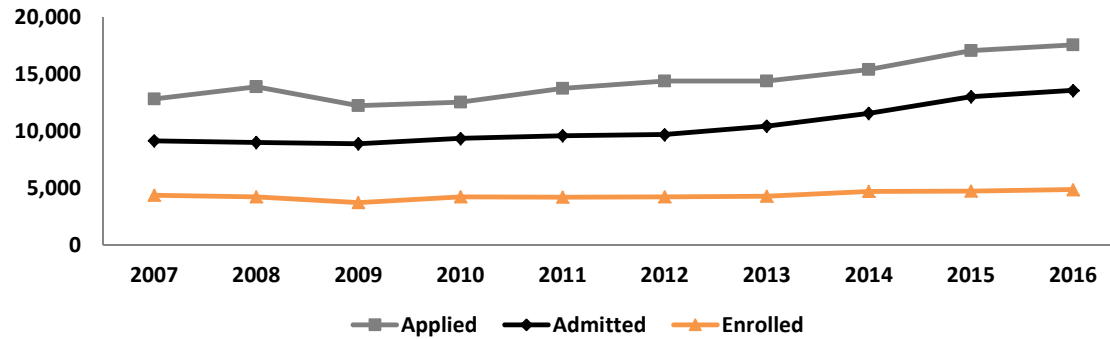

20 Year Trend of Average Test Scores, High School GPA, and Class Ranking First Time Freshmen Fall 1997-2016

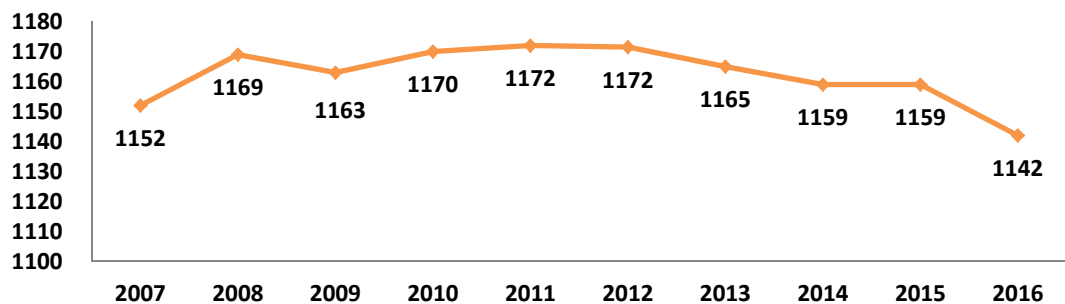

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2007-2016

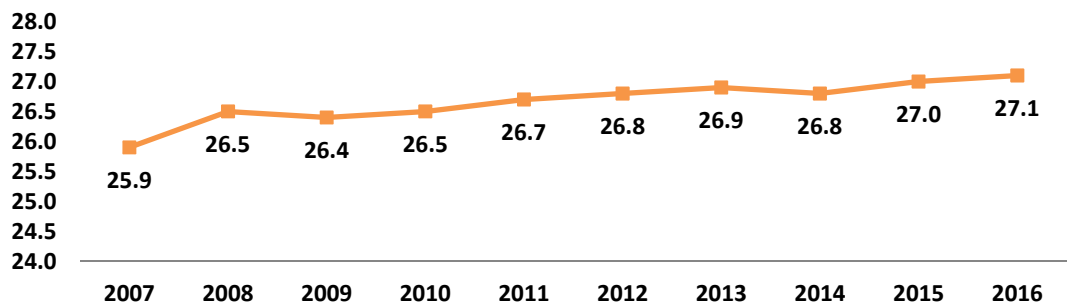

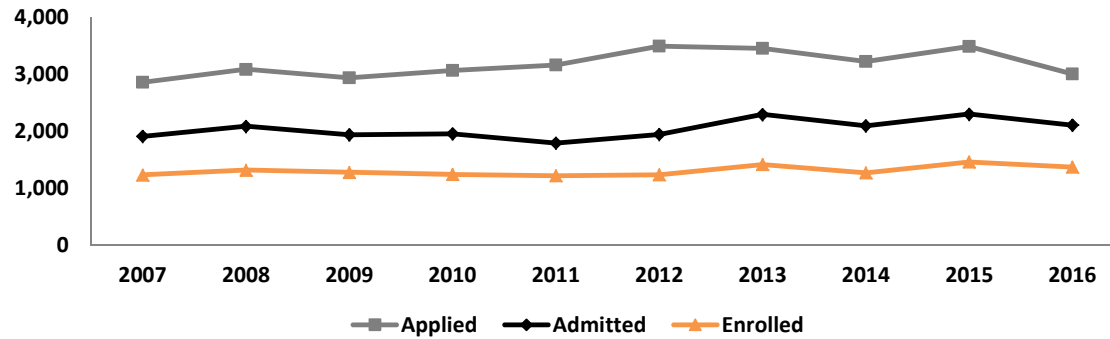

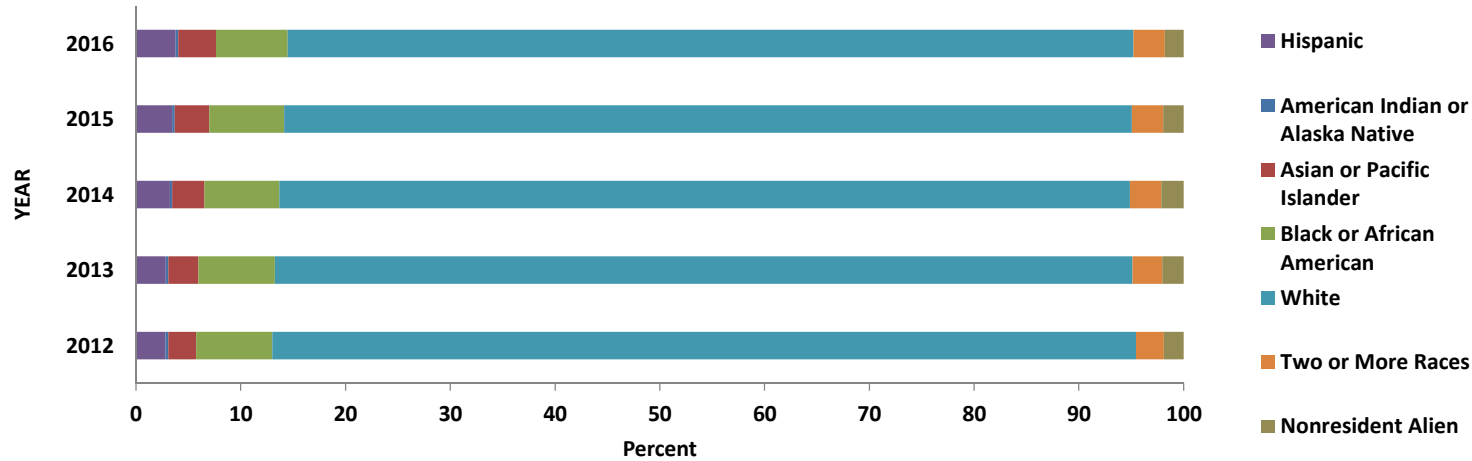

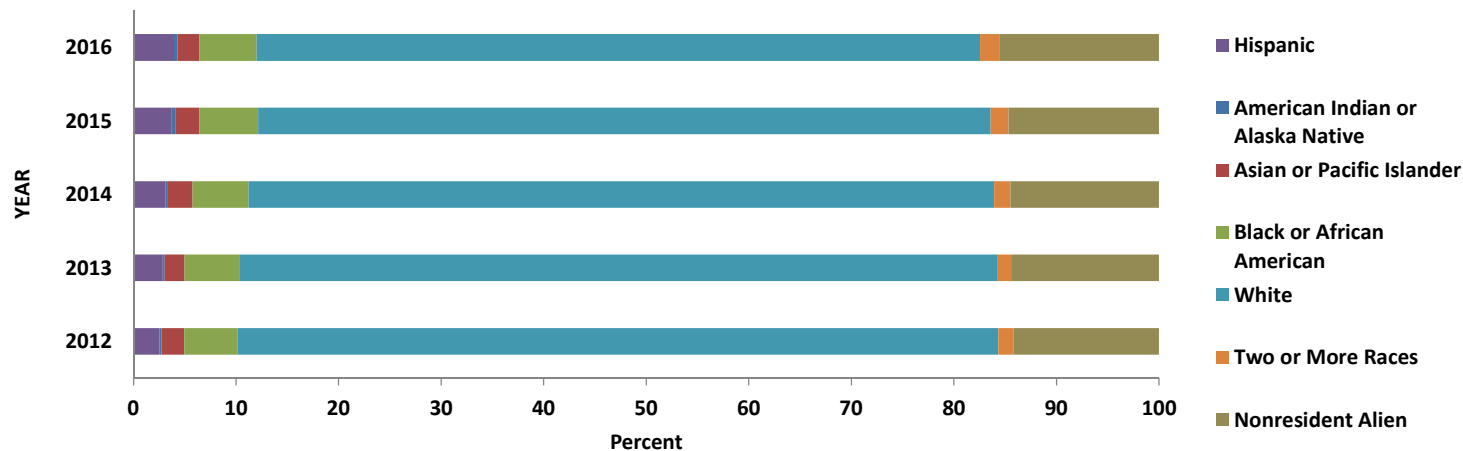

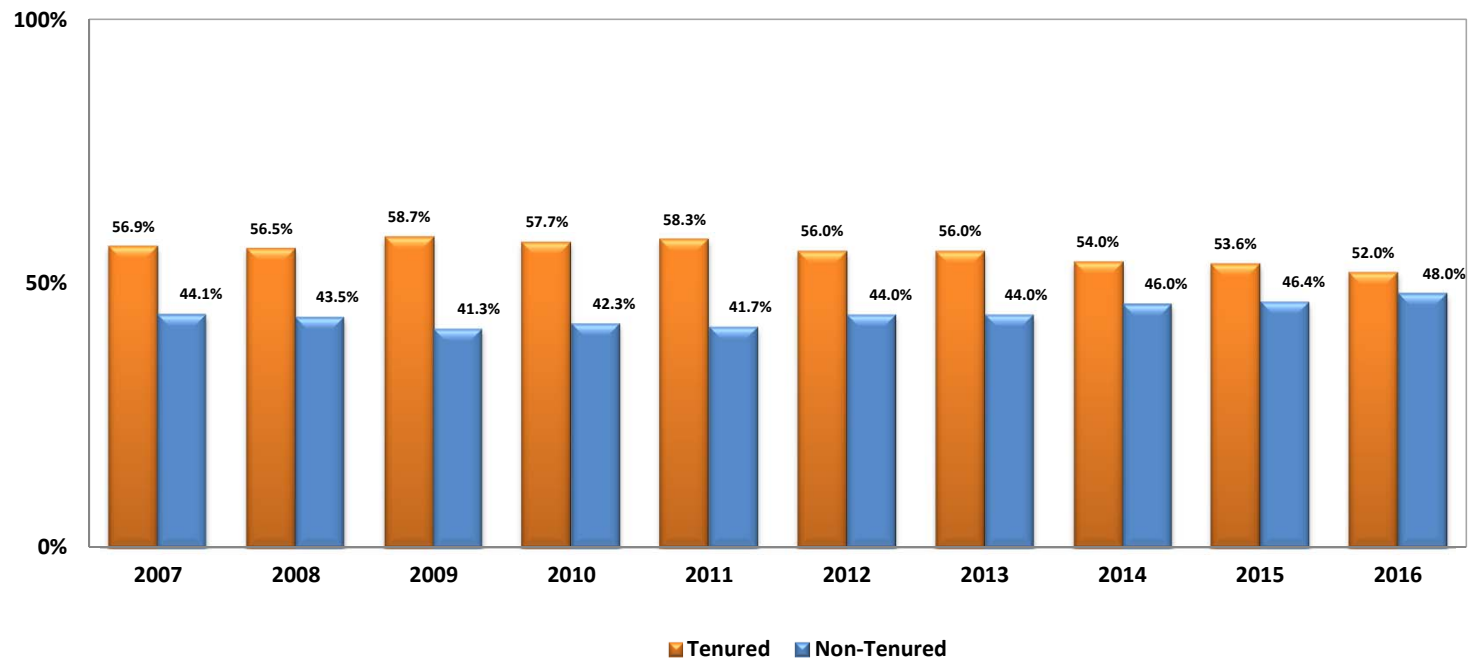

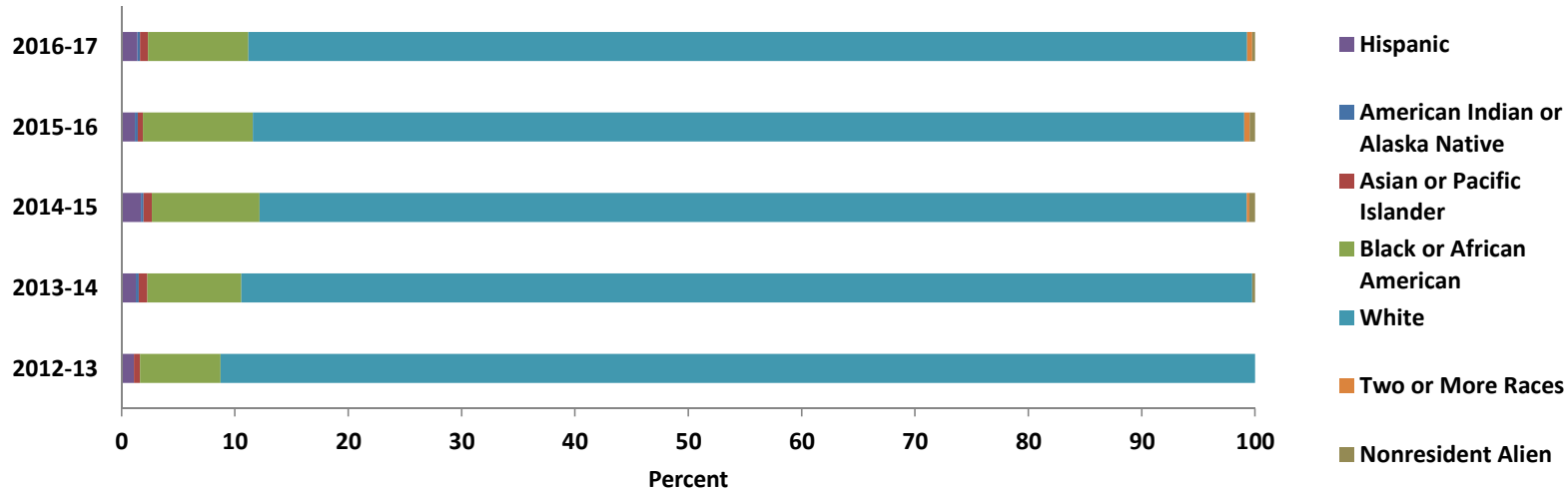

5 Year Trend of Executive and Administrative Employees By Race/Ethnicity Fall 2012-2016

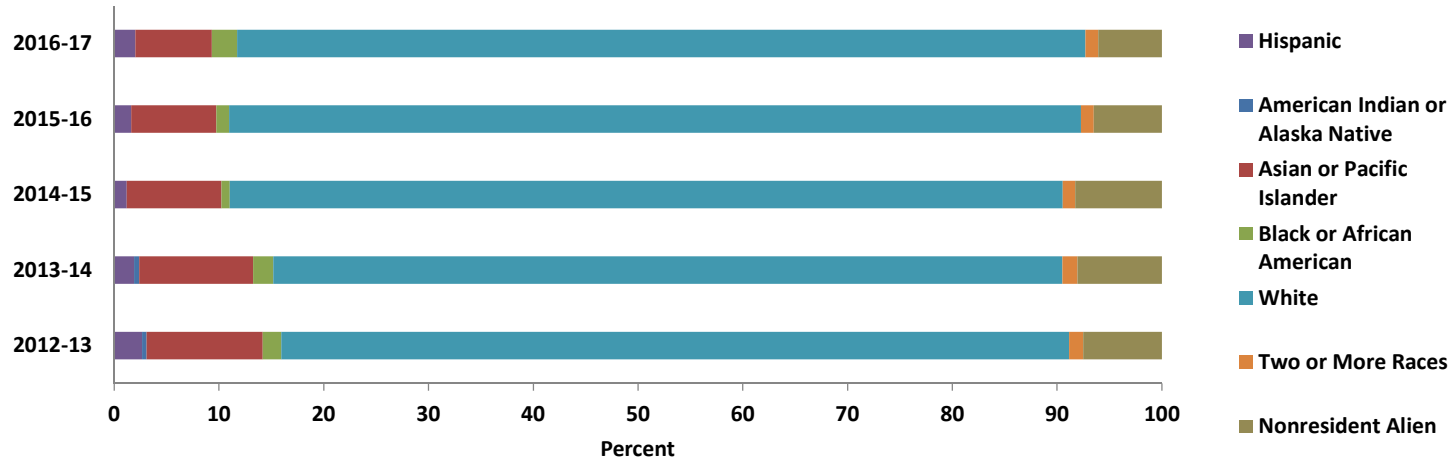

5 Year Trend of Research and Public Service Faculty By Race/Ethnicity Fall 2012-2016

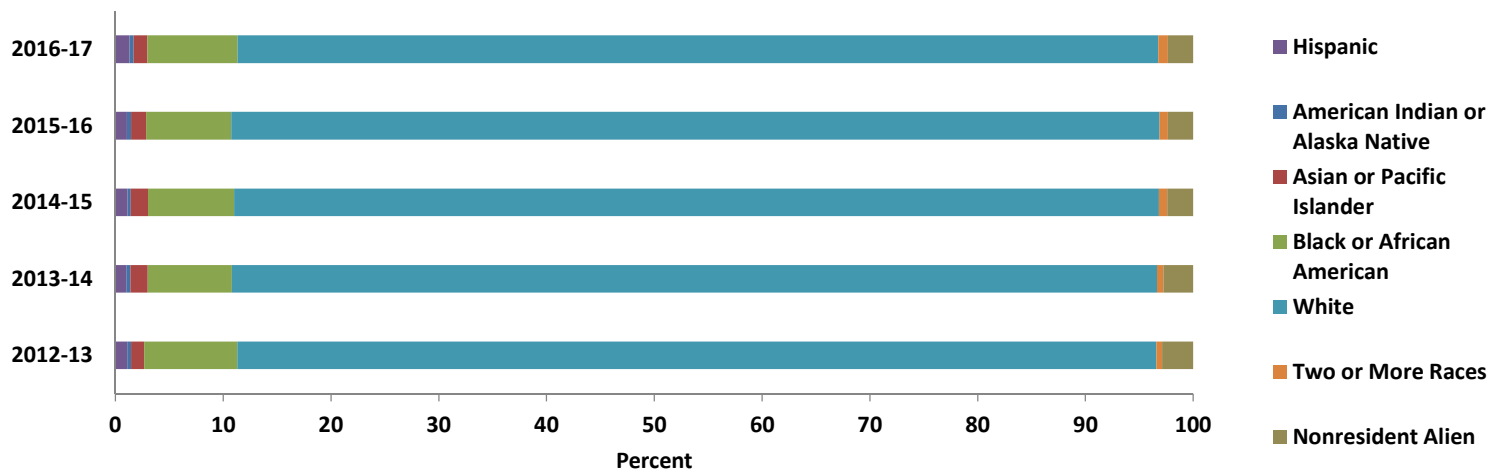

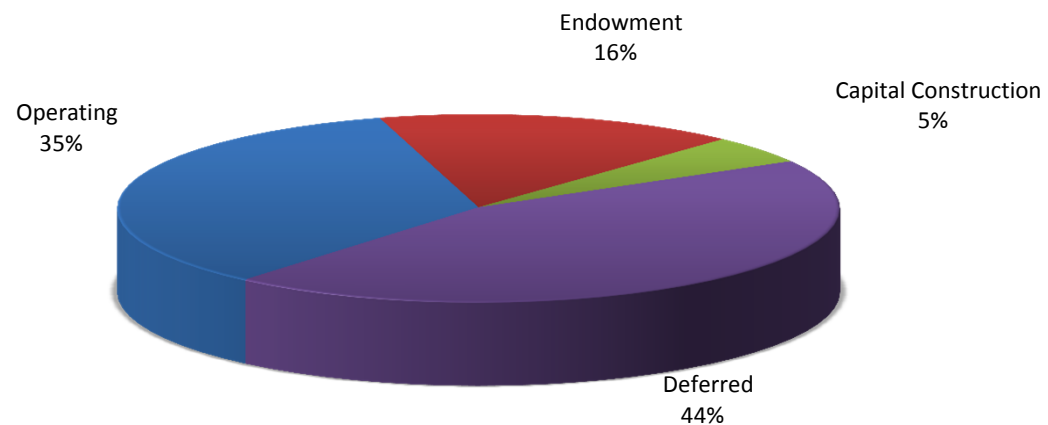


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

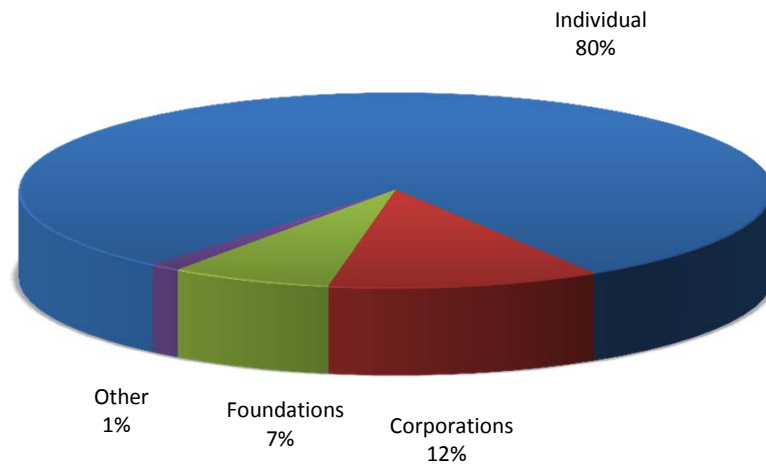


UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

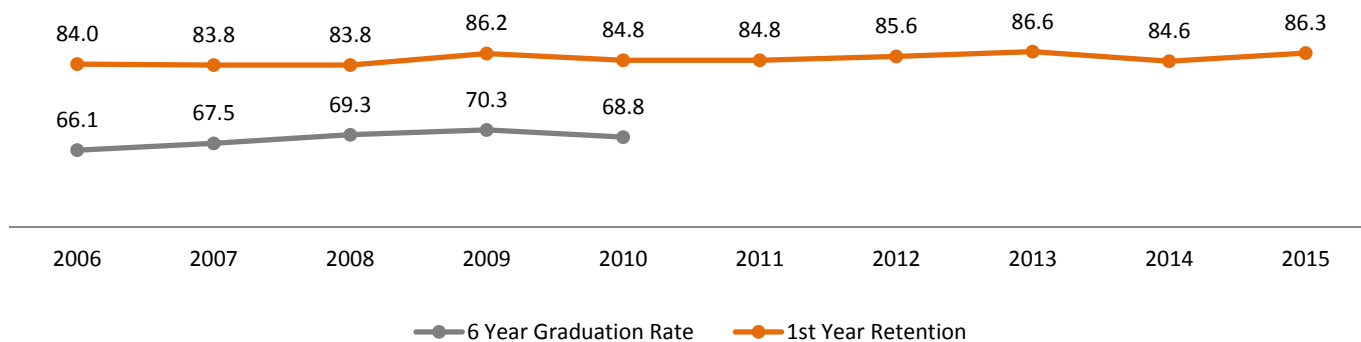

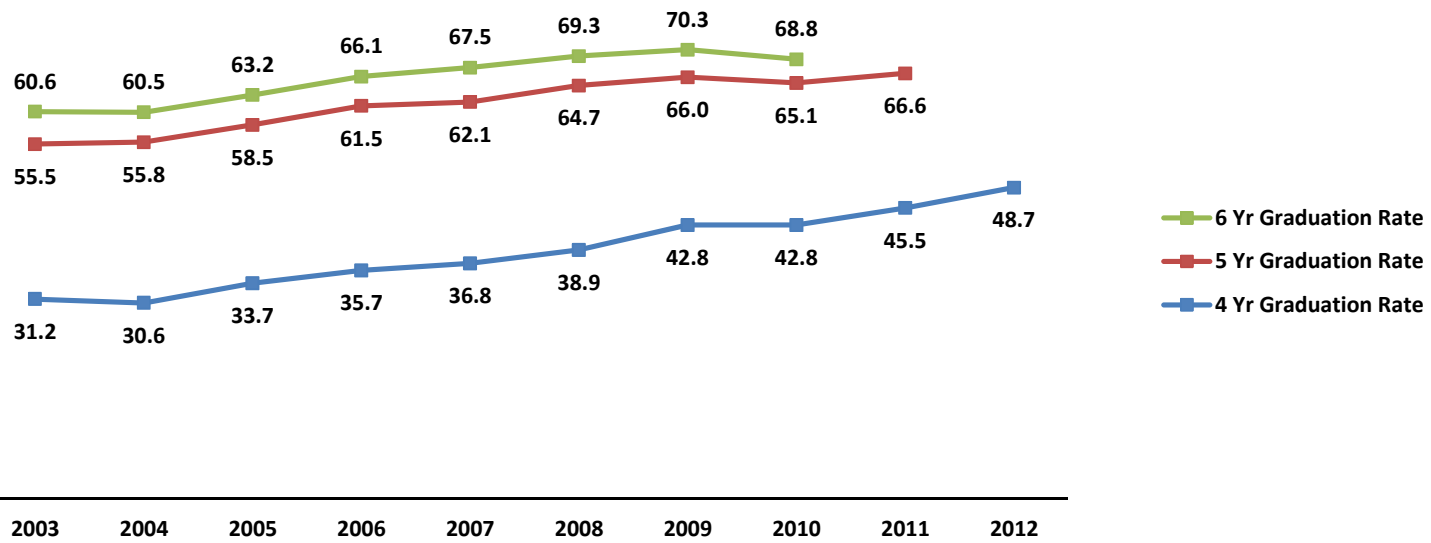
10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Full-time Freshman Fall Cohorts 2006-2015

10 Year Trend of Fall Term Graduation Rates First-Time Full-Time Freshman

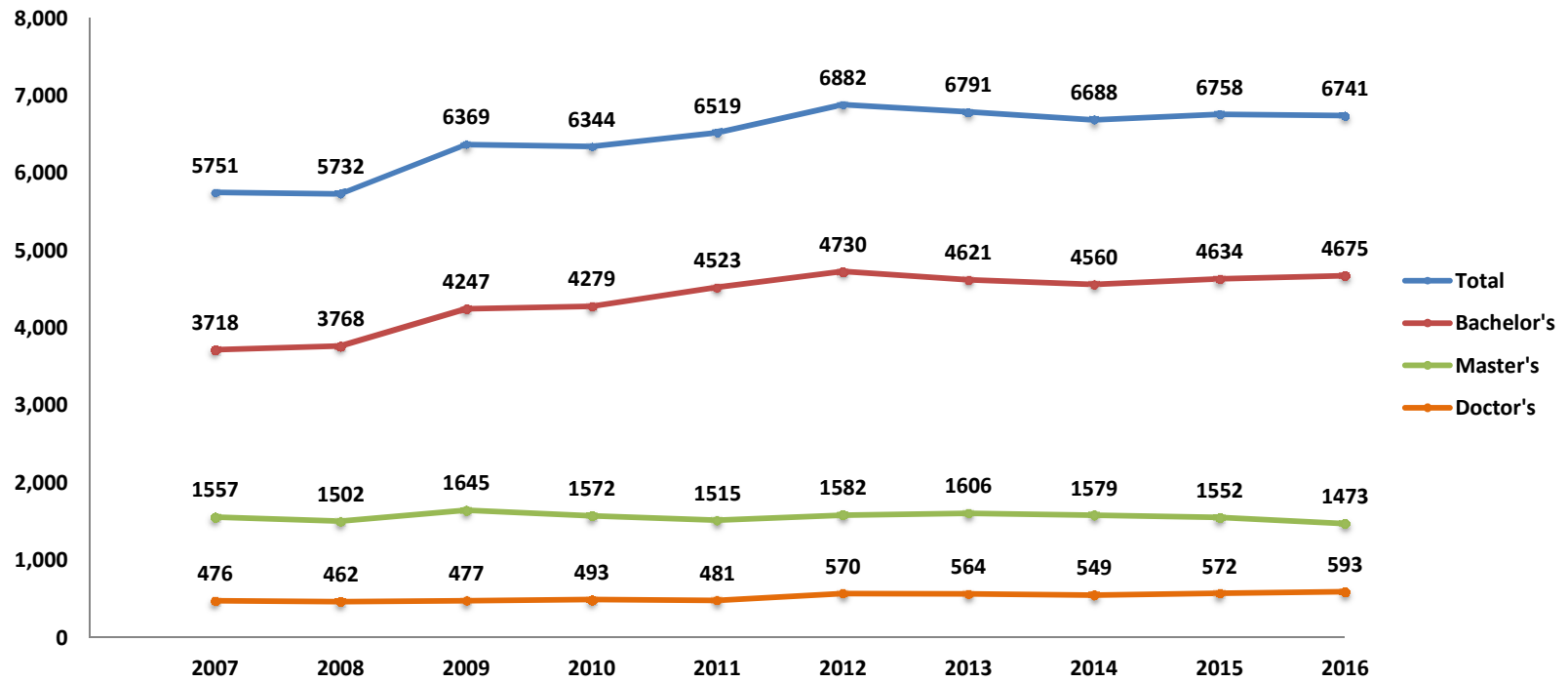

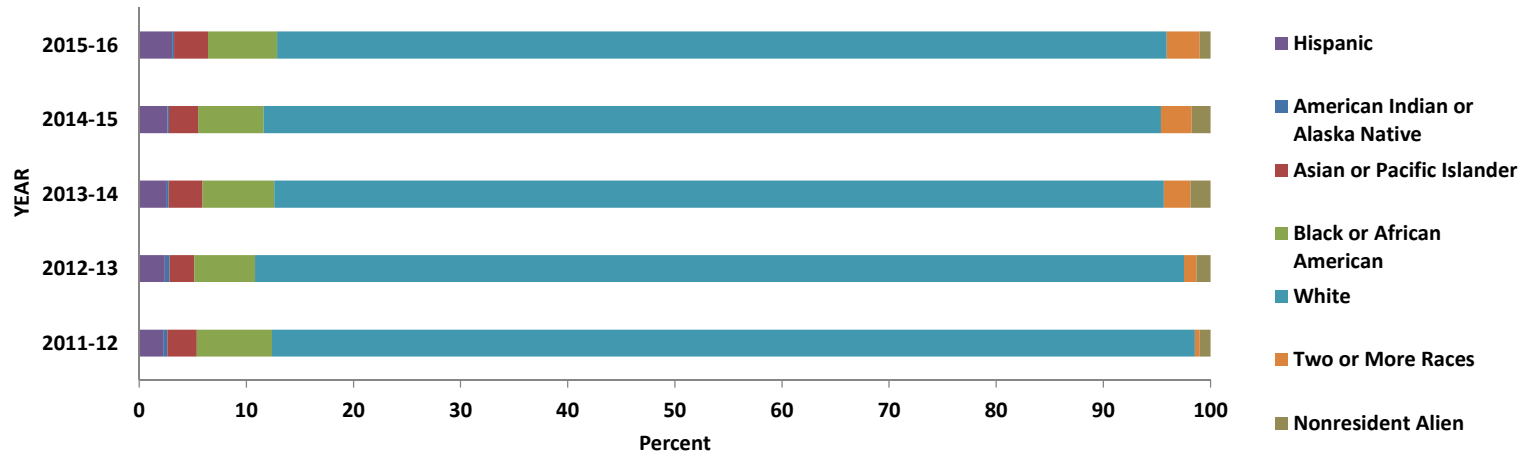

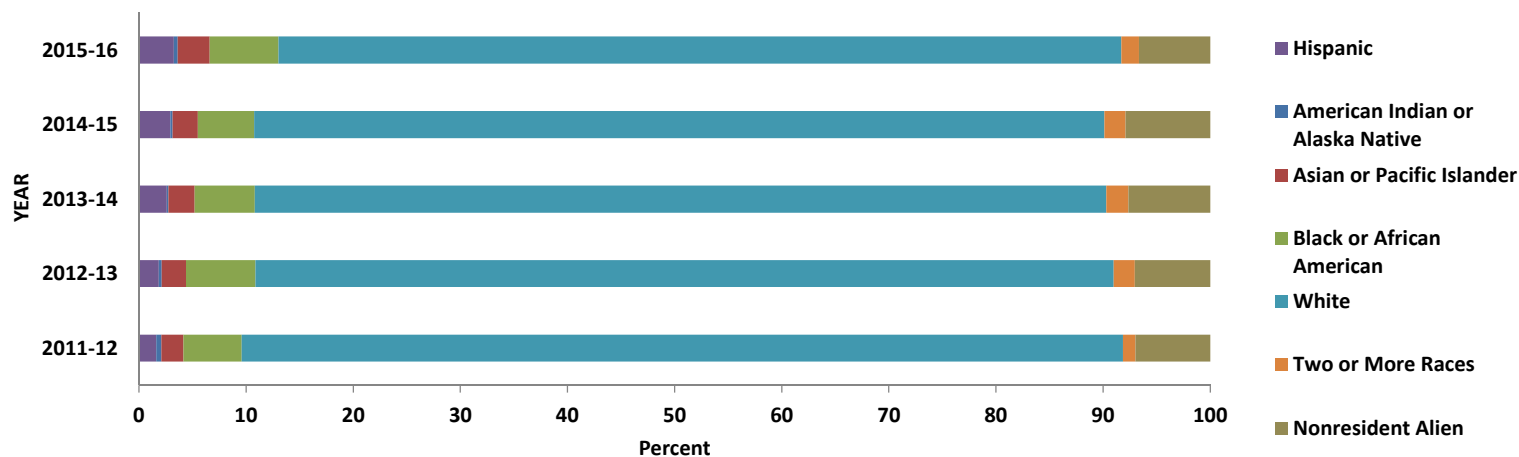
5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity Fiscal Year 2012-2016

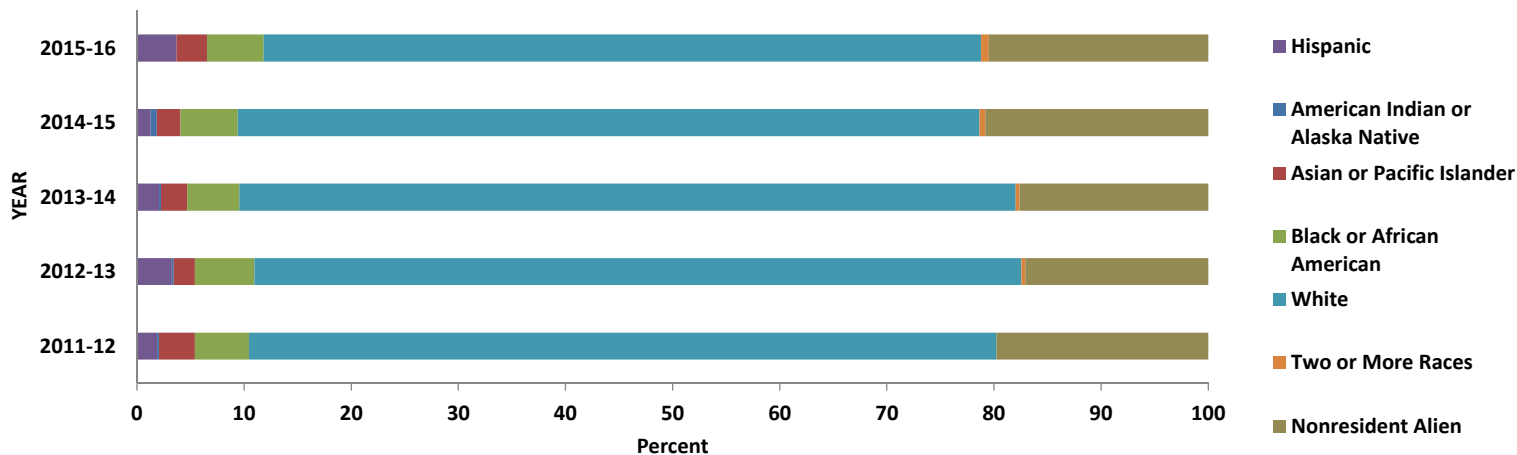
5 Year Trend of Master's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity Fiscal Year 2012-2016
